Costs explanation

Cultural mediation: To establish a dialogue on ocean senses and governance with the communities in Mato Grosso, and Tanzania in connection to the Kronprins Håkon expedition, we need support from two community members, respectively proficient in the native languages, Portuguese and Kiswahili, as well as in English: their work is expected to cover the post-expedition phase, by collaborating with the project coordinators (Poto and Panieri, AKMA), developing learning toolkits with the schools, and assistance in the phase of the publication of the results (1 expected co-authored and interdisciplinary publication (6 months of work in total). In particular, we have identified **two local and indigenous experts (one per each community)**. The experts are currently working as volunteers in local legal aid organizations, not employed by the involved institutions and therefore in need for financial support to contribute to this project.

Project assistance: We will need 1 project assistant, fluent in English (preferably English native speaker), able to assist us after the expedition, during the field work with the schools and in collaboration with the local cultural mediators. The project assistant will work under the overall direction of the project coordinator. Her/his responsibilities will include: 1. Assisting in the organization of the research expedition, meeting and webinar, including the preparation and sending of invitations, logistics arrangements, making reservations, providing general support and liaising with the project

coordinators; 2. Making travel arrangements, , completing claim forms and maintaining an overview of travel and financial expenses, as required; 3. Assisting with background research and the drafting of documents and concept notes, compilation of reports; assisting with the preparation of communication materials for presentations, press releases, social media, and the website; 4. Performing other related tasks as assigned.

Dissemination and communication costs: in line with our developing strategy on an improvement of dissemination and communication costs (not covered by ECO CARE and currently developed only at a project proposal level INTPART 2022/decision pending), and to strengthen the digital platform developed in ECO CARE, we are planning to develop one documentary, which includes 3 short e-learning videos on: the protection of the oceans from an interdisciplinary perspective (law and marine geosciences). The cost of the documentary is expected to be around 20.000 nok (shooting and editing). To complement our visual law and legal design approach, we will need 4 illustrations (costs not covered by ECO CARE), to integrate the e-e-learning materials (2500 nok per illustration, for a total of 10.000 nok).
