Undervisningsmetode	<p>Regular supervision and instruction will take place with the ensemble(s) after agreement and according to a plan, weekly or in concentrated periods.</p> <p>The student will develop a project description for the organisation and content of the study and will have independent responsibility for writing their semester plan and planning their repertoire. This responsibility also includes practical organisation such as providing sheet music, booking rehearsal spaces, planning concerts, etc.</p> <p>The student will normally have one permanent ensemble throughout the duration of the course, but should also take part in other ensembles. In order to</p>



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	<p>acquire experience in leading ensembles, the student can be given supervision tasks with other ensembles at the Academy of Music.</p> <p>It is possible for the student to work with external ensembles if agreed upon in advance.</p>
Info om eventuelle arbeidskrav	<p>The following coursework requirements must be met before the student can take the exam:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Midway performance (20 min) in which the project description will also be presented and <b>evaluated</b>.</li><li>• Production and participation in two public concert performances with a combined repertoire of 30 minutes.</li><li>• Written programme notes.</li><li>• Repertoire list consisting of a performance time of 90 minutes</li><li>• Submission of the programme of music for the exam and written programme notes</li></ul>
